12-volt sprayers



12-volt sprayers are most often used on farms, vineyards and orchards for spot spraying of weeds around boundaries, in areas where there are problem weeds, around dams, buildings and the like. These units commonly use spraying pressures of 2-3 bar maximum to reduce drift of the spray to the crop, trees or vines.

In a nursery situation, perhaps one of the higher-pressure pumps to drive a lance at say 10-bar pressure might be more useful. Whatever your need, we probably have a unit to suit your application. Also – checked out our 12-volt **300 litre Trailed model** on our products page.

  <p>Contact details: Ph: 0448 511 771 E: don@hortspray.com</p>	<p>At left:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">⇒ 200 litre 12-volt sprayer for use on the back of RTV-type vehicles, or on a trailer or ute.⇒ This is one of the most versatile units – it can also drive a small boom of up to 4 metres in width – ideal as a herbicide unit on a small farm block or vineyard.⇒ With a flat base, it is quite easy to slide on and off a tray when empty.⇒ A big drain bung is fitted to allow for proper clean out.⇒ It has a large, 5.5" lid, with strainer, a very useful lance, and a 3-way ball valve to allow a boom to be connected.⇒ The tank has baffles built in, and the top is sloped to drain away liquid.⇒ The regulating valve and a good quality suction filter are mounted directly to the pump and easy to access.⇒ This unit is one of our favourites – it's very versatile and very good value for money. <p>At left:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">⇒ This product was developed by Don over several years whilst working as a product manager – with particular attention paid to the pump mounting and the large suction filter.⇒ Often, 12-volt sprayers break down due to poor suction, or blocked suction & farmers can't find the issue. Not so on this product.⇒ The filter is large and easy access. The lance is good quality, along with all the components.⇒ It has a high-quality pump, matched to the lance – with a pressure switch to shut off the pump when the trigger is closed on the gun. A large filling lid and large drain bung round out the features.
